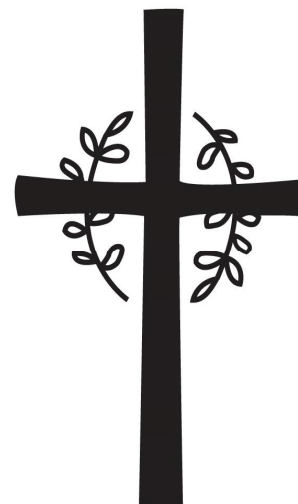

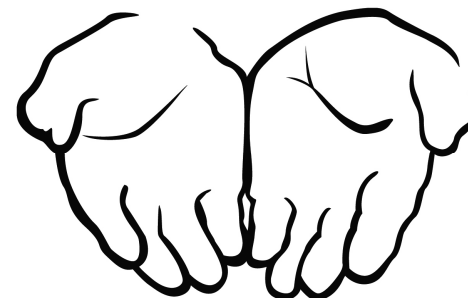
**Tuesday afternoon Bible Study** at 2:00pm. We continue to walk through the major stories of the bible together. Treats of course!
